- Develop and implement a yearly plan based on the Children's Ringette program provided by Ringette Ontario and Ringette Canada
- Design and implement practice plans
- Organize a committee of volunteers to assist with practices and games
- Adhere to all policies in accordance with Ringette Ontario and Oshawa Storm Ringette Association including but not limited to, Respect in Sport, Rowan's Law, Fair Play, Fair Ice and Rule of Two
- Be knowledgeable of the Official Rules of Ringette

Qualifications:

- Head Coach must fulfill the qualifications required by the position by November 30th of the current playing season as stipulated by Ringette Ontario
- Head Coach must provide a current Criminal Record Check or confirm that one is on file with the Oshawa Storm Ringette Association
